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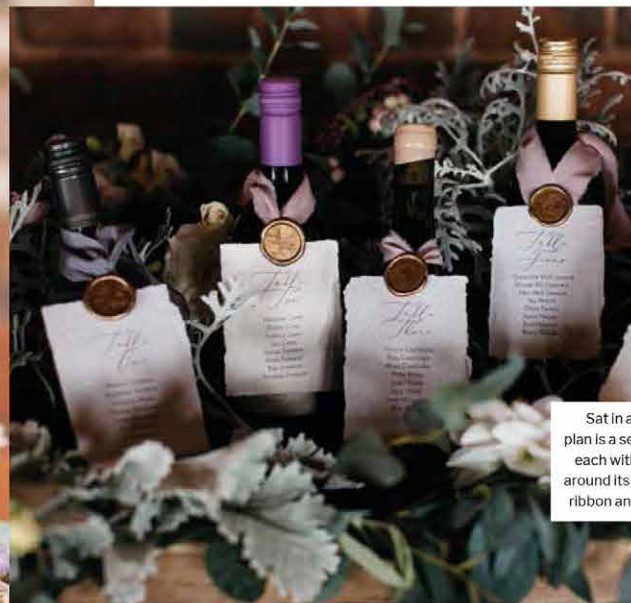


STYLED SHOOT

A fine vintage

Sat in a crate, the seating plan is a set of wine bottles, each with a table list hung around its neck with mauve ribbon and a gold wax seal.



The earthiness of the table's linens and grape bunches was contrasted with fine gold cutlery and brass candlestick holders.

Inspired by the natural beauty of Brickhouse Vineyard's grounds, this bridal shoot's tonal palette of blackberry and wine, with subtle accents of lavender, lilac and gold, reflected the land's rich bounty. "We couldn't help but be drawn to the glorious grapes," says stylist Nikki Sherriff, adding "the Devon countryside is gorgeous, but these shades, combined with the laidback styling helped to create a Provençal wedding ambience."

The elegantly homespun atmosphere was reflected in the ceremony area, with charming French doors, textural foliage and florals in a spectrum of purples from lilac to plum. Similarly, the bespoke seating plan and tablescape combined natural

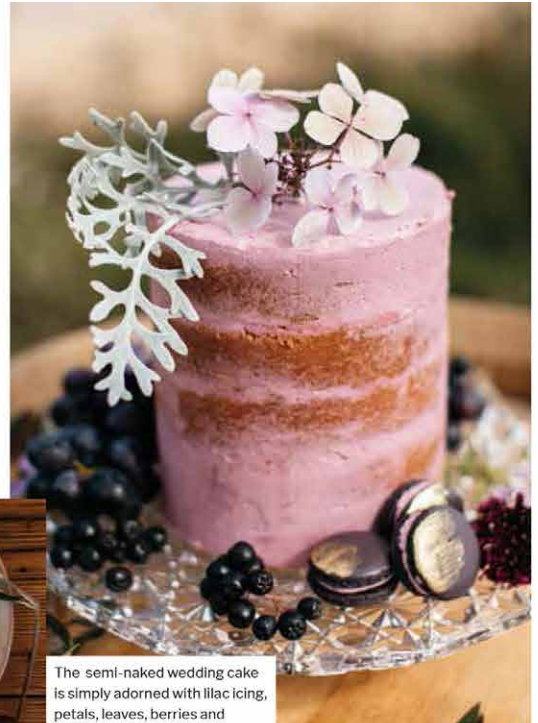
linens, vines and foraged berries with a touch of gold for a rustic banquet feel.
